The Pleasant Valley Cubs Meeting was called to order by President Gerilynn at 6:32pm. There were 16 members present.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

Amanda Flyte motioned to approve the January 2014 meeting minutes, Erin Maxwell seconded it, all approved, minutes submitted.

**PRESIDENT:**

Gerilynn thanked everyone for coming, stating camp went well. No rain date was needed. Rita's ice was at camp as a fundraiser earning the cubs \$90.00. All uniforms for football have been handed out. Picture day will be Saturday August 16<sup>th</sup> @ 11am with a rain date of 8/17/14. ESU Warrior breakfast will be Saturday August 23<sup>rd</sup> @ 7am. The cost is \$1 donation. This is for football players. The PVHS football team will have a home scrimmage on 8/22 @ 6pm. All Cubs are encouraged to attend for support. Practice pants will still be available for sale this week. Mouth pieces and pink laces will be continued to be available at practice. The pink sock orders have gone out and are due on 8/14/14. The head tables will be moved between the 85's & 100's practice fields. The league schedule needs to be adjusted for games. Once it is updated we will update the cubs webpage. It is not clear any of the changes will affect the PV Cubs. The Cubs will host a playoff game as well as the Senior Bowl Game. One defibulator has been deemed out of service. We are not going to replace it as we still have one and West End Ambulance will be onsite for all home games. **FOOTBALL COORDINATOR:**

Chris stated that the first week of practice went well. All equipment has been handed out with the exception of 4 or 5. Our home game schedule will remain 130's, Flags, 85's 100's for our home games. 130's will start at 11am. We will have a scrimmage against on Thursday August 14<sup>th</sup>. The format will be 10 -10. Parents cannot be on the field for any reason unless called out by a coach for injury. The only persons allowed on the field for practice and games are rostered coaches and board members with clearances. The scrimmage will not involve cheerleaders.

**CHEER COORDINATOR:**

Gerilynn: This cheer our cheer numbers are: 16 flags, 13 85's, 15 100's, 5 on 130s. That is a total of 49 cheer leaders this year. Some girls have not attended but have been contacts. Items purchased off the budget are weight balls, balance boards and pink poms to be shared between all squads. Small mega phones have been ordered. Gerilynn Appointed Erin Hnat as cheer coordinator. Erin Unfortunately could not make it to today's meeting due to work conflict. Erin will now take over the cheer e-mail and can be reached there with any questions or concerns. No stunting is to be done by anyone outside of practice without a coach to supervise.

### **LEAGUE MEETING:**

The league picnic was yesterday. Gerilynn thanked Brittany, Samantha and Angelo for attending on behalf of the cubs. We have now received our ID cards. The team parents will hold onto the ID card books that will contain a copy of the birth certificate. These are not needed for cheerleaders. The end of the season all-star game is now called the senior bowl. PV will be in the North with Palmerton, Marion and Leighton & Little Royals. Flags, 85's & 100's will submit 6 players. 130's will submit 5 players. Players selected to play must first be those moving up. The names are due by September league meeting on September 24<sup>th</sup>. You will need the child's shirt size. Gerilynn suggested when selecting the girls, you look at attendance, participation and enthusiasm. The league bylaws are required to be at each game. It will be kept in a binder on the bench. The head coach and football coordinator are the only ones allowed to challenge a play. Each team gets one time-out per half. Pat Guerissi added that the bath game on October 12<sup>th</sup> will be a pink-out. Asking all attendees to wear pink to the game. Patt Guerissi also made a motion for \$100.00 to be donated to the bath cancer fundraiser.

### **OLD BUSINESS:**

We will not be taking on a community service imitative this year. Homecoming has been selected for October 5<sup>th</sup>. A committee will be needed to organize this event. Pink poms have been ordered. Shoulder pad cleaning has taken place; one parent partook to earn a workbond point. Gerilynn thanked all the coaches who came out to assist with equipment handouts. ### **NEW BUSSINESS:**

Workbond: will be 10 points this season per family. There will be 2 drink and 2 food donations. 6 points will be for working. 1 of the 6 points will be reserved for the play off or Senior Bowl Game. Each team parents will need to fulfill one working shift. If you do not want to do food or drink donation you can work shifts instead. The donation items can be a financial strain and the option to work instead is available. You cannot donate items in replacement of your working shifts.

The second round of play-offs will be on November 2<sup>nd</sup> hosted by Pleasant Valley. The Senior Bowl will be on November 15<sup>th</sup>.

Only the flags level squad will have a team parent on the field.

The ID card must be filled out, with picture and birth certificate for the child to be eligible to play.

Shed cleaning will be on Monday 8/18. This will be a workbond opportunity. 10 slots are available.

Uniform hands out will be Monday 8/11 at practice starting with 130's-100's-85's-flags. Older players get choice of number over younger players.
