**OPENING:**

**CHEER COORDINATOR:**

Gerilynn welcomed all cheer coaches to attend the league picnic on August 9<sup>th</sup>. Clearances are due ASAP for all cheer coaches. We are still in need of a 130 cheer coach. ToniAnn will assist if someone is need of help.

**LEAGUE MEETING:**

League picnic is August 9<sup>th</sup> @ Fullerton. It is a day when all of the teams come together before the season starts. The league has new bi-laws for cheerleaders. One new bi-law is the cheer ages brackets will be the same as football follows. Birth certificates are due by August 15<sup>th</sup> to the league. The league requires all players have a birth certificate on file.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

It was suggested by Angelo Deluzio to look into a little league sponsorship to help spread awareness about our organization. It has been decided that it would be unfair to pick one sport or team over another. We continue to help communication flow.

Practices will be Monday – Thursday 6p-8pm until school begins. Once school begins, practice will be Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday still from 6p-8p.

Practices are held at the middle school by the tennis courts.

If you have a child on multiple teams, please communicate this with the team parent and coaches which field you will be at. We recommend you stay with the younger player. You must make sure there is a responsible adult at all times on premise with your child. You can never drop off your child and leave.

### **NEW BUSSINESS:**

October 5, 2014 will be our homecoming game. We will recognize our players for all their hard work.

It is unclear at this point how many work-bond points will be required. These points will be dependent upon the number of families and number of home games. No sign-ups have been held yet.

Anyone who decides they wish to no longer play prior to August 11<sup>th</sup>, will be refunded minus a \$25 processing fee. After August 11<sup>th</sup> no refund will be issued. You will still be held responsible for your work bond requirements. Each task or donatable item is equivalent to one point. Workbond points are per family, not per player.

Pink Poms will be ordered for the cheerleaders to use during the month of October.

July 29<sup>th</sup> @ 9am is the first opportunity to earn workbond points cleaning shoulder pads and unboxing helmets.

Equipment handouts will be on August 2, from 9-12. Coaches are requested to help with handouts.

Schuykill valley will be there to order sneakers, socks, bloomers and other items. This requires a separate check.

Whatever you order from them is yours to keep.

Dress code: for camp athletic shorts and tee shirt with sneakers or cleats. For practice, all football players must be in full uniform including a mouth piece.
